**Comment 1:**

As discussed during the 12 May 1993, Operable Units 15, 16, and 17 meeting, the Navy will modify Section 8.0 -Ecological Assessment- from a broad three-phased approach to a more focused two-phased approach. This change follows suggestions from State Natural Resource Trustees, NOAA, US Fish and Wildlife Service, and USEPA personnel and were concurred with by the Navy, FDEP, and USEPA. As agreed during the meeting, the Navy will only submit a separate and revised Section No. 8.0 -Ecological Assessment-.

**Response:**

Section 8 of the CSAP has been revised to address the comments from the meeting on May 12 and 13, 1993.
