Naval Air Station Pensacola.

I have reviewed the above referenced document dated November 1993 (received November 30, 1993) submitted for this site. The following comment needs to be addressed before this document can be considered final:

Figure 2-1 lacks the designation of the wetlands located south of the Bilgewater Treatment Plant, that were impacted by the waste oil spill from the Bilgewater Treatment Plant. Though the remediation of this site will be under the petroleum agreement with the state following F.A.C. 17-770, this wetland still requires wetland designation in this document.

To expedite the revision process, all that is needed to this document to be considered final, is an amended Figure 2-1 and other relevant text that pertains to this wetland to be submitted. The amended pages can then be used to replace the appropriate pages.
