

SUBJECT: Draft Remedial Investigation (RI), Site 33 (Oak Grove  
Campground), Naval Air Station Pensacola.

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Subsequent to the submittal of the subject document in January 1994, a Draft Immediate Removal Action Work Plan was submitted in March 1994. The removal action entails the removal and disposal of stained soil containing semivolatiles and inorganics detected during the RI investigation. The presence of TCE, 1,1-DCA and inorganics in groundwater will not be addressed in this removal action.

Following the removal action, confirmatory samples will be collected and the RI will be resubmitted. Thus, the Pensacola Tier I team has agreed that the RI in its present state will not be reviewed, but will be reviewed when the RI is resubmitted following the removal action.
