Dear Ms. Humphris:

This letter provides official notification that Subject Site 3 is transferred to the Petroleum Program. Fieldwork completed to date at the subject site has resulted in only petroleum related constitutes as indicated in the analytical results of the Technical Memorandum dated June 1994. This was addressed at the NAS Pensacola Tier I Partnering meeting held in Atlanta on 23 & 24 March 1995 and a decision was made to continue the investigation under the Petroleum Program. The Site investigation will be completed under F.A.C. 62-770 and therefore will not be tracked in future Site Management Plans. This Site name has been changed to UST 18.

A conference call held 5 May 1995 between David Clowes (FDEP), Brian Caldwell (Ensafe), and myself established the following:

- a. Preparation of a separate Contamination Assessment Plan is not required since an existing Sampling and Analysis Plan under the CERCLA program has been approved and **subsequent agreements concerning additional sampling had been agreed to by the NAS Pensacola Tier 1 team.**
- b. Investigation protocol should use Florida Cleanup Goals for soil on Military Sites as the benchmark values for soil evaluation and remediation (as opposed to OVA soil headspace).
- c. Analytical protocol for groundwater should comply with the requirements set forth in F.A.C. 62-770.
