## Comments sought about EPA cleanup

Officials of the Pensacola Naval Air Station have scheduled a public meeting to discuss a proposed remedial action plan for a contaminated site near Oak Grove Campground.

The meeting will be at 7:30 p.m. today at Pensacola Junior College, Warrington Campus, in the T. Felton Harrison Building.

As part of the environmental Superfund cleanup program at NAS, contaminated soil was removed from the site in 1994. The site is now in the final remediation stage. The Navy has proposed a plan of no further action.

Navy officials say an important aspect of the final cleanup plan is public input — to ensure that the concerns of the local community are considered. The public can respond to the final action through June 30.
