Dear Mr. Hill:

I have completed the technical review of the subject documents, dated February 10, 1995 (received February 13, 1995). The following comments should be addressed:

1. Why was a second Draft Final Workplan submitted? The previous version of this document, dated November 30, 1993 was also a Draft Final. The submission of previous versions of this document and the reason(s) for the resubmission should be substantiated.
2. Most of the information provided in the Workplan and Sampling and Analysis Plan (Draft, submitted February 15, 1995) appears to be redundant. In the future, it would appear to be more cost effective to combine the Workplan and SAP for each site/category, and also remove the unnecessary duplication.

Response to FDEP Comment:

3. Page 2-1: The response to my comment contradicts the text and also the December 1994 Tier I Partnering decision. The decision was that if the wetlands were only impacted by a petroleum site, then the assessment/remediation would be addressed under the petroleum agreement. The decision was not that these wetlands would be excluded from consideration. From the data presented in the subject document, the wetlands appear to be affected by OU-10; thus should be included in Site 41.
