Dear Mr. Hill:

I have completed the technical review of the above
referenced document dated July 22, 1995 (received July 24, 1995).
The following comments need to be addressed.


1. Figure 2-1 should show the location of Buildings 1994 and 2657 which are indicated in the text on page 5.
2. Figure 2-4 should identify the location of the adjacent I.R. Sites 17, 22, and 24.
3. Figure 2-6 should show the locations of Buildings 1681 and 3873 as indicated in the text on page 14.
4. Figure 4-1 shows the proposed monitoring wells 1 and 2 at the perimeter of the delineated site boundary, and monitoring well 3 upgradient of the site. Monitoring wells should be placed in the area of known disposal or trenching operations. As this is a screening site, monitoring well 3 should be moved to the center of the delineated site.
5. The first sentence under Soil Sampling Strategy on page 30, should be rewritten for clarification. The sentence states that "one 2-foot sample collected from each following 5-foot depth interval" will be sampled. This does not specify which 2-feet of soil will be sampled. The sentence should read: "All boring locations will be sampled at the following intervals: 0 to 1-foot, 5 to 7 feet, 10 to 12 feet, 15 to 17

feet etc., until the water table is reached. This is based on an estimated water table at 17 feet below land surface."
