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**Naval Air Station Pensacola
Restoration Advisory Board Meeting Minutes
August 27,1996**

1. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Community Co-Chairperson John Early. First order of business: Minutes from the 23 July 1996 meeting were reviewed. Move to the order of business:

2. RAB Member Concerns/Community Concerns

Community and RAB member concerns will be combined in future agenda item listings. A letter was received from Escambia County Environmental Health Services concerning contaminants coming from a drainage ditch exiting the base near Pleasant Grove. The navy has stated that nothing was coming from the base but it appeared that it was coming from a private sources off the base and flowing through the base. The letter agreed with the navy's assessment and stated that the ditch has been dry and no substances were found from the suspected area. The Escambia County Environmental Health Services Department has contacted the base to send sample results that reveal gray water contamination, however, no sampling data has been provided as of this date. This concern has been passed to Ron Joyner for action and will be an agenda item for the next meeting.

Agenda item for the next meeting: PAO will bring copy of media and mailing listing for RAE3 members to review. RAE3 will contact Terry Joseph of West Florida Regional Planning Commission to obtain listings of various professional organizations that may be interested in RAB activities.

3. Nomination of Alternate Community Co-Chair:

Jerry Westmoreland has been nominated and has accepted appointment as the next Alternate Community Co-Chair for the 1996/97 session commencing September 1996.

4. Progress Report Update by Bill Hill:

Final closeout report and site characterization report was submitted for site 36 on August 12, 1996 and a copy was placed in the repository. Traces of PAHs were found which coincided with former Underground Storage Tank (UST) locations or reported breaks in the former fuel line. Cleanup will be deferred to the UST program and a No Further Action has been proposed under the Installation Restoration program.

5. Other Business:

The 1997 Site Management Plan was briefly discussed. Bill Hill agreed to send a copy to RAB members for their review prior to the next RAB meeting.

Commander Monachino provided to the Public Affairs Office a copy of a Proposed Rule published in Volume 61, Number 152 of the Federal Register concerning Rules and Regulations for Restoration Advisory Boards. Copies will be sent to all RAB members to review for discussion at the next RAB meeting,

A first draft of a Contaminate Source Diagram (**CSD**) was presented by Henry Beiro. Additions and modifications to the diagram was discussed and it was agreed that the CSD would be a topic at the next Partnering Meeting. Henry Beiro will bring a second draft to the next RAB meeting and Bill Hill will update RAB members regarding the subject at the Partnering Meeting.

Next meeting is scheduled for **24** September 1996.


6. Closing Remarks:
