I have completed the technical review of the above referenced documents dated December 1997 (received November 12, 1997) and all appear adequate for their intent. However, on page 4 of the Site 2 Proposed Plan (PP), the last sentence for Alternative 4 indicates the alternative does not pose excess risk to the ecosystem. This is incorrect, as the alternative leaves in place contamination which still poses an ecological risk as determined in the remedial investigation. This should be reflected in the PP accordingly.
