
Dear Captain Bahr:

The Department of Environmental Protection concurs with the Navy's Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Unit 4, Naval Air Station Pensacola.

The ROD specifies excavation and disposal of soils exceeding the industrial cleanup goals; restricting the site to industrial use through the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for land use controls; monitoring of natural attenuation processes in the groundwater; and restricting use of groundwater at the site through the MOA for land use controls. The remedy is cost effective and provides adequate protection of public health, welfare, and the environment,
