1. Check-In

The conference call began at approximately 1:00 pm. Discussions began regarding what the remedial response would be if game fish tissue indicated risk and if there was not a connection to NAS Pensacola. EPA and the U of F representatives indicated that comparison of the site data to a more regional fish tissue background for the Gulf of Mexico was acceptable. If the Site 40 data are within the range of the background concentrations, the participants agreed that no further action for human health would be required for Bayou Grande. One document cited was "PCB in Water, Sediment and Biota or Escambia Bay" from the Bulletin of Environment and Toxicology". This was not an extensive search, only an example of literature that may be available.

Action Item: EnSafe will search for available literature to establish a PCB background concentration for fish tissue. The site data will then be compared to the range of contaminant background concentrations identified.
