

DECLARATION OF THE RECORD OF DECISION

Site Name and Location

Operable Unit 3
Site 2 — Waterfront Sediments
Naval Air Station
Pensacola, Florida

Statement of Basis and Purpose

This decision document (Record of Decision) presents the selected remedial action for Operable Unit 3 (OU 3) also called Site 2, an area of waterfront sediments at Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Florida. The selected remedy was chosen in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA), as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA), 42 U.S.C. '9601 et seq., and, to the extent practicable, in a manner consistent with the National Contingency Plan (NCP), 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 300. This decision is based on the administrative record for Site 2 at Naval Air Station Pensacola.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection concur with the selected remedy.

Assessment of the Site

The response action selected in this record of decision is necessary to protect public human health, welfare, and the environment.

Description of Selected Remedy

This action is the first remedial action for the site. No CERCLA action is necessary for the protection of human health, welfare, and the environment at the site.

Statutory Determinations

The selected remedy is No Action. None of the CERCLA Section 121 statutory determinations are necessary in this section since no remedial action is selected. No CERCLA action is necessary for the protection of human health, welfare, and the environment at the site. This remedy results in hazardous substances remaining onsite; therefore, a 5-year review will be required as recommended by the NCP.
