I understand you are not able to schedule a on-board review of the Site 3 Pistol Range UFP SAP for a while.

Because of the simplicity of the site, a pistol range berm, I would like to go ahead and schedule the sampling activity. We have incorporated state comments discussed during the DQO meetings and I do not know of any outstanding issues. The sampling grid will cover and extend beyond the area that should contain the highest concentrations of contaminants, and we will step out as needed. Lab analysis will include Pb, Antimony Arsenic, Copper,

Tin & Zinc.

We had the berm cleared of heavy brush, and would like to sample while it is still easily accessible. Also, I want the team to get some experience before taking on larger projects. There are also contractual reasons, the contract accumulates overhead charges as long as it is open.

As long as you do not object, we would like to proceed "at risk" in need be, with the sampling activity.
