I have completed my review of the First and Second Quarter, Year 2009, Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Reports, Underground Storage Tank Site 17, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated October 2009 (received October 29, 2009), prepared and submitted by Aerostar Environmental Services, Inc. The reports are suitable for their intended use and are approved. Data contained in the reports indicate that contaminant concentrations in groundwater have decreased below groundwater cleanup target levels for two consecutive events. Therefore, no further action is required to address groundwater at this site. A Site Rehabilitation Completion Report should be prepared pursuant to Rule 62-770.690(10), Florida Administrative Code. This report should include figures and tables with analytical results for all media (soil and groundwater) that support the determination that the site has been remediated.
