Dear Mr. Hill,

The Department has completed the technical review of the above referenced document dated January 16, 2007 (received February 2, 2007 via email). The report for the subject document and have the following comments.

1. **Page 5, left column, 1st paragraph:** The groundwater is considered to be a Human Health Risk, the Department requires that a Land Use Control (LUC) be placed on this and that it be stated in this proposed plan.
2. **Page 5, right column, 2nd paragraph:** Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) are not listed in the groundwater in this paragraph, but they are listed on (page 8, right column, 5th paragraph) for groundwater at Sites 11 and 30, please explain this inconsistency.
3. **Page 5, right column, 4th paragraph:** This paragraph states; "The remedies identified and evaluated in the FS were selected to fulfill the Florida Level II criteria", this needs to be changed to "Level IIB criteria for soil".
4. **Page 5, right column, 4th paragraph:** This paragraph states; "And one FS groundwater alternative was evaluated pursuant to Florida Level III Criteria" this needs to be changed to "Level IID criteria for soil".
