Comments

1. Page 1-4, Section 1.3; - Remove the statement "...until contract period of performance expires". The objective of this groundwater monitoring plan is to monitor the contaminants until the remedial goals are achieved. The contract performance period is not an objective of the groundwater monitoring.
2. Page 4-1, First Paragraph – The sampling frequency should be added to the text, "monitoring wells will be sampled semi-annually... ". The wells to be sampled should also be listed and identified by depth, (shallow, intermediate, ..) and groundwater elevations should be collected.
