


1. Page 3-3, 3rd paragraph: Please clarify the groundwater flow explanation in this paragraph.
2. Page 3-8, Section 3.2.6, 2nd paragraph: Calculate the groundwater velocity for both the shallow and intermediate aquifers and include the findings in this paragraph.
3. Page 4-2, Section 4.1.2: Produce a figure showing the analytical results reported in this section.
4. Figure 3-2: Correct the Free product delineation line to include
MW6-S.






