These Sampling and Analysis Plans are well put together documents and are generally adequate for their intended task with one comment below.

The only comment that we have concerns the plan for Site 44. In this plan, the new proposed monitoring well locations displayed on figure 3-2 are well placed if the source is found to be the Wash Rack Area or the UST location, which most probably will be the case. However, if the Flammable Storage Area is found to be contaminated in the soil investigation, it would be prudent to install a well directly down gradient perhaps 75 or 100 feet away.
