The Department of Environmental Protection has reviewed the Record of Decision for Operable Unit 18, Site 43, Demolition Debris Disposal Area, Naval Air Station Pensacola, and concurs with the Navy's selected remedy. The selected remedy for Site 43 includes three major components: (1) excavation and off-site disposal of the most contaminated soil (in unpaved areas) to meet the Department's commercial/industrial soil cleanup target levels; (2) groundwater monitoring; and (3) land use controls to prohibit future residential use, to ensure maintenance of paved areas, and to prohibit groundwater use.
