The Department has reviewed the Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) for Remedial Action for Operable Unit 18: Site 43, Demolition Debris Disposal Area, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated August 2012 (received August 6, 2012), prepared by AGVIQ-CH2M HILL Constructors, Inc. I have the following comments on the Draft SAP:

- (1) In Worksheet #11, two documents are referenced in the text that are not included in the Reference Section at the back of the document: (FDEP, 2005) and (EPA, 2011).
- (2) In the last sentence on page 54, AGVIQ is misspelled.
- (3) The methodology for collecting soil samples in the field and analyzing those samples for lead using x-ray fluorescence (XRF) needs to be described in the text. The Draft SAP only references SESDPROC-107-R2 which provides a general discussion on methods to collect XRF measurements in the field. This Draft SAP should provide a detailed account of how the soil samples to be measured in the field using XRF are to be collected, handled, processed and analyzed.
