I have completed my review of the Revised Draft Interim Remedial Action Completion Report (IRACR), Operable Unit 13 – Sites 8 and 24, Rifle Range Disposal and DDT Mixing Area, Revision 1, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated August 2014 (received September 3, 2014), prepared and submitted by Resolution Consultants. The Revised Draft IRACR was provided in a red line/strikeout version and was accompanied by responses to EPA and Department comments on a previous draft of the report. Except for the response to my fourth comment, the responses to my comments are acceptable and appear to have adequately incorporated into the report. In the response to my fourth comment, Resolution Consultants states that “Documentation of EPA approval of the elimination of pesticides and VOCs from the program is not available.” This raises questions regarding how the original groundwater monitoring program approved pursuant to the 2006 Record of Decision has changed to the current groundwater monitoring program provided in Table 3-1 and how approval for those changes were provided. Please review all past correspondence regarding the groundwater monitoring program and provide in Section 3.0 an explanation on how the monitoring program changed and how those changes were approved.
