Dear Mr. Darby:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency has received and reviewed the document referenced above. The report documents the implementation of land use controls (LUC), removal of soils above cleanup criteria, and the installation of the monitoring well network as established in the Record of Decision dated September 27, 2000. The monitoring well network will be used to document the progression of the natural attenuation currently ongoing in the groundwater. Once criteria have been met in groundwater a final closeout report can be written. LUCs will be in place until the parties agree that unlimited exposure and unlimited use of the site is possible without adverse health concerns.
