
I have completed my review of the Federal Facilities Agreement, Draft Site Management Plan, Fiscal Year 2011, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated September 2010 (received September 3, 2010), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. I have the following comments on the Draft Site Management Plan:

- (1) On page 2-6, top of page, please change "NAS Pensacola Preliminary Documents" to "NAS Pensacola Primary Documents". On the same page, please remove the bullet from the line for "NAS Pensacola Secondary Documents". Still on the same page, please add Treatability Study Reports to the list of NAS Pensacola Secondary Documents.
- (2) In Appendix B, page 1, UST 020 - Site 19 Fuel Farm Pipeline, ID 129, it says the Department should have already received the Draft Final RAP Addendum and that the Department's review time has expired. The Department has no record of receiving this document. These dates should be revised.
- (3) In Appendix B, page 2, UST 024 - Site 37 Sherman Field Fuel Farm, ID 198, it says the Department should have already received the Draft Final RAP Addendum. The Department has no record of receiving this document as of yet.
- (4) In Appendix B, page 2, UST 025 - NASP Building 1932, ID 235, it says the Department should have already received the Draft Final RAP Addendum. The Department has no record of receiving this document as of yet.

- (5) In Appendix B, page 3, there are 5 petroleum sites listed as having Final Remedial Action Plans dated between April 3, 2009 and April 1, 2010. The Department has no record of Final RAPs having been received on or near those dates. The Department does have the following documents:
- a. NASP Building 782 - The Department received a groundwater monitoring report in July 2010.
 - b. TACAN Facility 1917 - The Department received groundwater monitoring reports in June and September 2010.
 - c. Naval Hospital Building 2270 - The Department has no record of ever having received a document for this site. Is this a new site?
 - d. Chevalier Field Building 3644 - The Department received groundwater monitoring reports in June and September 2010.
 - e. Seawall Site - The Department last received a Site Assessment Report for this site which received an on-board review.
