I have completed my review of the Federal Facilities Agreement, Draft Final Site Management Plan, Fiscal Year 2011, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated October 2010 (received October 21, 2010), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. My comments on the Draft FY 2011 SMP appear to have been adequately addressed. I have the following comments on the Draft Final Site Management Plan:

- (1) The Draft Feasibility Study for Operable Unit 16, Site 41, Wetlands, is due on November 30, 2010. The Navy has indicated that because of several unresolved issues with refining the list of contaminants of concern at this site as well the upcoming holiday season, the Navy will require additional time to prepare and submit the Feasibility Study. I accept a modification to the submittal date for this delivery of this document for 30 additional calendar days.
- (2) The Draft Proposed Plan for Operable Unit 21, Site 46, Former Building 72, is due on December 15, 2010. The Navy has indicated that it will need additional time to submit this document. I can concur with moving the delivery date of this document an additional 30 calendar days.
