Dear Mr. Glover:

I have completed the technical review of the above referenced document dated April 1999 (received April 27, 1999). Please excuse the late review of this report. I have only a few comments regarding the conclusions and recommendations presented in this document.

The source of tetrachlorethene (PCE) and 1,1,1,2-Tetrachloroethane detected in the deep monitoring well DMW-12 should be investigated under the installation restoration (IR) program. I do not consider their occurrence isolated since PCE was detected in DMW-12 earlier during the June 4, 1996 sampling event. 1,1,1,2-Tetrachloroethane is a similar compound to PCE; however, it is not a known degradation product. 1,1,1,2-Tetrachloroethane concentration (2.0 ug/L) exceeded the groundwater cleanup target level (GCTL) of 1.3 ug/L specified in 62-777 Florida Administrative Code (FAC).

I recommend that confirmatory groundwater samples be collected from monitoring wells MW-2, MW-5, MW-8, MW-10, and MW-13, and analyzed for TRPH and EDB. In addition, water level measurements should be collected during the sampling event. An Addendum to the report should be submitted presenting the data and a recommendation for the site.


