
Dear Mr. Schoolfield:

I have reviewed the Draft Final Tier II Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP), Extended Site Inspection Plan for NAS Pensacola - Magazine Point Bombing Target, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated November 2011 (received November 18, 2011), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The SAP proposes to conduct further site assessment using an Incremental Sampling Methodology (ISM) approach described in Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) - 05, located in Appendix A of the SAP. The Department has not formally accepted this methodology and is currently attempting to draft guidance for conducting site assessment using ISM. I had hoped the guidance would have been available for distribution by this point, but that is not the case. My general response to the SAP is that it appears to be a reasonable effort to determine whether the top six inches of soil have been adversely impacted by metals or explosives. I believe upon the Navy's resolving EPA's comments on the Tier II SAP, the Department will accept the SAP as final.
