I have reviewed the Work Plan Revision, Biosparging Interim Measures Site Assessment at Sherman Field Former Fuel Farm, Underground Storage Tank (UST) 24, Revision No. 02, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated November 2011 (received by e-mail on November 14, 2011), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The Work Plan Revision was developed to describe work to be conducted investigating whether chemicals of concern are present in the vadose zone at levels that would represent a continuing source to groundwater contamination, confirming the vertical placement for interim measure biosparge wells, collecting soil vapor data prior to biosparging operations for use as baseline data, installing nested vadose zone monitoring points, installing up to 39 interim measure biosparge wells, and installing two new monitoring wells. The Work Plan is adequate for its intent and represents the recommendations resulting from the Technical Memorandum for Discussion, Proposed Path Forward for Interim Measure, UST 24 Site, Former Sherman Field Fuel Farm, dated October 31, 2011 (received by e-mail October 31, 2011), and the subsequent teleconference of November 3, 2011.
