The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the Preliminary Assessment (PA) for the Outlying Field Bronson (OLFB) EPA ID# FL6170024610. Overall, the PA report is well done and the geology and soils information is quite sufficient. The following comments address the potential targets, the surface water pathway, and the recommendations for each specific area. In general, the EPA agrees with the overall findings of the PA. However, the EPA is of the opinion that a full Site Inspection (SI) should be performed at OLFB.
