This is to confirm EPA response in regard to your letter dated December 29, 1992 (copy enclosed) pertaining to the Atlantic Fleet Weapons Training and Camp Garcia, P.R. facilities. As you requested in the aforementioned letter, we have deleted the Atlantic Fleet Weapon site from the federal facilities docket as it is contiguous with the already listed Camp Garcia facility. In addition, as per your letter, we have changed the name of the Camp Garcia/Atlantic Fleet site to Eastern Vieques, P.R.

Finally, since EPA reviewed and evaluated the Navy's Installation Report from 1984 which covered both the Camp Garcia and Atlantic Fleet Weapons site, no further reports pertaining to the site need be submitted to us at this time. As you are aware, EPA recommended no further action upon reviewing the subject Installation Assessment Report. However, should you know of or become aware of any environmental problems concerning hazardous waste which occurred subsequent to the 1984 Installation report, you should provide any information on such to this office for further evaluation.
