In reply to your letter of June 12, 1995 which provided comments on the Draft Resources Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation Work Plan for U.S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads, we have determined that a meeting among personnel from the Navy, Baker Environmental (Navy contractor), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region II, and TRC Environmental (EPA contractor) may assist in resolving a number of the addressed concerns.
