The U.S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads is required by law to establish Information Repositories at facilities available to the general public. This Information Repository consists of information upon which the U.S. Navy, the Puerto Rico Environmental Quality Board (EQB), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) base its selection of corrective action for a particular area under the Naval Station Installation Restoration (IR) Program.

The IR Program assesses, studies, and implements remedial actions on sites which have become contaminated during the performance of our mission. By providing the public with greater access to these documents, it is our intention that they be better equipped to comment constructively on on-going investigations, and to understand the issues related to the selection of the response action at the site.

By this mean, we are providing the library with two bookshelves to display the documents.

We appreciate having the Ceiba's public library as a designated Information Repository facility for the U.S Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads. The enclosed documents, along with any future documents relating to technical activities at the sites, should be available for public review. The documents should be treated as a non-circulating reference but they can be copied.
