

- For SWMUs #27, #28, #29 and AOC A, the text under the status column should be revised since its refers at first to SWMU #16. The reviewer do not understand the relevance of the status of SWMU #16 when discussing the other three SWMUs, if this is a typographical error, please correct. If not, please clarify.
- For SWMU #53 there is a reference to the remedial activities at SWMU #46. The reviewer do not understand the relevance of the status of SWMU #46 when discussing the other three SWMUs, if this is a typographical error, please correct. If not, please clarify.
