Dear Mr. Gordon:

As discussed in our meeting on 30 October 2008, the Navy plans to submit a revision to the SWMU 76 RCRA Facility Investigation Work Plan based on the comments received from the National Guard Bureau. The schedule for submittal of the revised work plan is 31 March 2009.

The Navy plans to include a schedule for implementation of the work plan of such duration that will allow the Army Reserve or National Guard Bureau time to acquire the property and execute the actions necessary to complete the work. In addition, the Navy expects the National Guard Bureau or the Army Reserve (current license holder of the property) to enter into some enforceable agreement with EPA removing the requirement to address SWMU 76 from the Navy Administrative Order on Consent. The Navy understands that this agreement will take some time to negotiate and is expected to occur after the transfer of the property from the Navy to the other federal service.
