The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region VIII has determined that the United States Pollution Control, Inc. (acronym USPCI) Cell Z landfill application meets the requirements of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA).


The enclosed Approval contains language which is restrictive in terms of a limited subset of waste types acceptable for landfilling based on EPA's evaluation of USPCI's current PCB analytical procedures. The compliance and corrective measures conditions, as well as the initially limited Approval life of one year, have been retained to enforce steady progress toward improved operations.

The application was the subject of a September 3, 1992, public meeting which EPA held at the Tooele County Courthouse in Tooele, Utah. Favorable comments regarding the application were made by citizens, business interests and a County Commissioner. A representative of an environmental group asked several questions and later submitted written comments. USPCI also submitted written comments regarding the Draft Approval. The public comment period ran from August 17 through September 8, 1992. A brief summary of all public comments, as well as EPA's response, will be prepared for the record.

As you will see upon review of the enclosed Cell Z Approval, EPA has incorporated some changes as a result of public comments. We believe we have struck an acceptable balance between your expressed concerns and the agency's and the public's need for environmental protection. An edited version of the Draft Approval showing the changes (bracketed language deleted, bold language added) is also enclosed so that you can easily recognize the revisions. The final signed version is the official Approval.

We look forward to an engaging year of dialog and steady advancement in your waste management operations. If you have any questions regarding the Cell Z Approval, please contact Mr. Thomas C. Pauling at (303) 293-0978.
