The report is also titled Draft Data Report, First Semi-Annual Groundwater Sampling Event, Site 4, Outlying Landing Field Saufley. I have the following comments on the report:

- (1) Water level measurements were not provided with the report. If water level measurements were not collected, please state the reason they were not collected. If they were collected, please provide a table with the water level measurements and calculated potentiometer surface elevation and a figure depicting groundwater flow and potentiometric surface elevation contours.
- (2) On Figure 6, the chem-box with the TRPH results for monitoring well MW-05S incorrectly points to monitoring well MW-08S.
