The attached file of environmental data was included in an email I sent dated 13 July and is the lab report indicating soil samples from the site are free of contamination exceeding FDEP regulatory criteria ergo the site is clean.

The Geotech report is in FedEx for delivery on July 26th. The only other report your waiting for is the report from me which would include these two reports (Lab and Geotech) in the appendix and indicate the site should be treated as a typical site with no environmental contamination concerns. I will provide this as soon as possible.
