# Naval Air Station Whiting Field Installation Restoration Program

## Public Notice of Remedial Actions

Based on the results of a Remedial Investigation (RI), Feasibility Studies (FSs), and Feasibility Study Addendums (FSAs) the Navy will implement remedial actions at two sites at Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field.

At Sites 10 and 11 Land Use Controls (LUCs) are proposed to restrict future use of the site to non-residential/recreational. The proposed final remedy for each site is as follows:

- **Site 10 – Southeast Open Disposal Area A – Surface and Subsurface Soil:** LUCs, including an existing soil cover, will be implemented at Site 10 to reduce potential exposure risk, restrict future use to non-residential activities and to prohibit disturbance of the soil cover. Site 10 will be available for non-residential/recreational use.
- **Site 11 – Southeast Open Disposal Area B – Surface and Subsurface Soil:** LUCs will be implemented at Site 11 restricting future use to non-residential activities and to

prohibit soil removal from the site. Site 11 will be available for non-residential/recreational use.

Upon completion of these remedial actions, no additional action will be required at Sites 10 and 11.

Copies of the RI, FS, FSAs and the Proposed Plans will be available for public review at the NAS Whiting Field Information Repository on August 15, 2007.
