**Naval Air Station Whiting Field
Installation Restoration Program
Public Notice of Remedial Actions**

Based on the results of a Remedial Investigation (RI), Feasibility Studies (FSs), and Feasibility Study Addendums (FSAs) the Navy will implement remedial actions at two sites at Naval Air Station (NAS) Whiting Field.

At Site 2 No Further Action is proposed and at Site 16 Land Use Controls (LUCs) are proposed to restrict future use of the site to non-residential/non-recreational. The proposed final remedy for each site is as follows:

• **Site 2 - Northwest Open Disposal Area - Surface and Subsurface Soil:** No Further Action (NFA) will be implemented at Site 2. Site 2 will be available for both residential and non-residential use.

• **Site 16 - Open Disposal and Burning Area - Surface and Subsurface Soil:** LUCs will be implemented at Site 16 restricting future use to non-residential/non-recreational activities and prohibiting digging at and/or soil removal from the site. Site 16 will be available for non-residential/non-recreational use.

Upon completion of these remedial actions, no additional action will be required at Sites 2 and 16.

Copies of the RI, FS, FSAs and the Proposed Plans will be available for public review at the NAS Whiting Field Information Repository on August 15, 2008.
