Dear Mr. Kissam:

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed the Record of Decision (ROD) for the Naval Air Station Whiting Field Operable Unit 9, Site 10, Southeast Open Disposal Area A. The selected remedy for Site 10 consists of Land Use Controls that will restrict the site to non-residential use and will prohibit digging, disturbing, or removing the existing soil cover without prior written approval from the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the Department. The restrictions will cover an area slightly larger than the boundaries of Site 10 to ensure that an appropriate buffer zone is created. Engineering controls consisting of warning signs and maintaining the existing soil cover are also part of the remedy. The Department concurs that this remedy should be protective of human health and the environment.
