

This is in response to your letter of December 24, 1987 in which you requested review and comments on the above reference document. Investigation and analyses carried out during this study appear to be adequate for characterizing the inactive waste sites that had been previously identified. Recommendations for continued work are appropriate. It should be noted that this facility is currently operating as a generator only and therefore not subject to 3004 (u) of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Amendments of 1984 (RCRA). However RCRA permitting staff ask to review the study have referred it to the RCRA Compliance Staff for a possible non-notifier determination.
