EPA has received the above referenced document and your letter of July 10, 1990. EPA disapproves this Work Plan for the following reasons:


1. Construction materials for monitoring wells were not evaluated for specific site conditions as requested in EPA comments.
2. Decontamination procedures are not those required by EPA Region IV Standard Operating Procedures and could lead to questionable data interpretation.

In addition information supporting no further study of some sites was not included in the Work Plan as agreed in your March 5, 1990, response to comments.

Any data collected by the Navy using this Work Plan may be rejected for use in Agency decisions if NAS Whiting Field is eventually placed on the National Priorities List.
