The Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your letter of August 30, 1990 regarding the Phase I Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Work Plan. The approval is conditional upon the following:

1. Data collected from PVC wells installed in Phase I will not be used in long term monitoring or in a risk assessment.
2. Decontamination procedures are placed in the Work Plan. This can easily be achieved by inserting the procedure from EPA's comments or Engineering Support Branch Standard Operating Procedures Manual. This is to ensure field crews have ready access to the procedure in the manual if any questions should arise.
3. That the work described in your letter for site 2 be added to the Phase II Work Plan.

EPA appreciates your cooperation in having resolved the outstanding issues on this Work Plan. EPA encourages you to proceed with field work at the earliest possible date.
