We would like further information on the Installation Restoration (IR) studies being performed at the naval facilities in Florida. As natural resource trustees, we are currently involved with the Naval Air Stations at Pensacola, Cecil Field, Jacksonville, and Key West. However, we only have partial information for the other facilities we know of in the state:

1. Underwater Sound Reference Detachment (Orlando, Florida)
2. Naval Training Center (Orlando, Florida)
3. Naval Underwater Systems Center Detachment (West Palm Beach, Florida)
4. Naval Surface Water Center Detachment (Hollywood, Florida)
5. Naval Coastal Systems Center (Panama City, Florida)
6. Naval Air Station Whiting Field (Milton, Florida)
7. Naval Station Mayport (Mayport, Florida)

We are aware that some of these sites currently have Federal Facilities Agreements.

We would like further information on these sites such as: current status; remedial investigation (RI) work plans; RI reports; feasibility studies; risk assessments; etc.
