This letter serves to convey my concurrence on the Proposed Plan for Site 1, the Former Northwest Disposal Area at NAS Whiting Field, in which the Navy proposes to implement Land Use Controls (LUCs). The LUCs will prohibit future residential use of this portion of the facility while allowing activities that involve less than full-time direct contact with the surface and subsurface soils at the site.
