

6.0 DECISION

On the basis of the findings at Site 24B, the Abandoned Firefighting Training Area, OLF Barin, Foley, Alabama, there is evidence to conclude that Site 24B may in the future cause environmental contamination or pose an unacceptable current or potential threat to human health or the environment. Therefore, the decision has been made to remove the burn pit from Site 24B. Following the pit's removal, additional soil sampling will be needed to confirm that the removal action has remediated the site to acceptable levels. Once this has been accomplished, the site will be removed from further consideration and no further action will be implemented. Letters of concurrence from USEPA and Alabama Department of Environmental Management constitute concurrence with the Remedial Action Decision at Site 24B.
