

Dear Mr. Adams:

After phone conversations with ABB concerning additional risk evaluation of Site 24B, the following will be acceptable with the Department for review of an NFA of Site 24B:

- Exposure scenarios evaluated can be limited to a child transient, adult transient, and maintenance worker. This was agreed upon with the assumption that if the facility were to be transferred, it would have to go through a BRAC closure, and would have additional exposure scenarios evaluated if need be.
- The exposure frequency for a transient scenario will be changed from the 30 days/year used in Risk Assessment dated September 1994, to 50 days/year for a more conservative calculation.
