1. The proposed Plan of Action and Milestone (POA&M) provided in reference (a) on the Solid Waste Assessment Test (SWAT) at the West Beach Landfill at Naval Air Station (NAS), Alameda is revised as follows:

Draft SWAT Proposal (Final Draft RI/FS Workplan)	Sep 88
Final SWAT Proposal (Final RI/FS Workplan)	Feb 89
Start of SWAT Test	Apr 89
Submission of SWAT Report	Aug 90

2. As indicated in reference (a), the SWAT at the West Beach Landfill is proposed as part of the ongoing RI/FS at NAS Alameda. The revised SWAT POA&M is based on the POA&M of the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) at NAS Alameda.

3. A SWAT at the 1943-1956 Disposal Area at NAS Alameda is also required, as discussed in reference (b). The SWAT at this site is also proposed as part of the ongoing RI/FS program at NAS Alameda. The POA&M on the 1943-1956 Disposal Area SWAT is the same as that on the West Beach Landfill.

4. In references (b) and (c), NAS Alameda and the staff of Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) concurred, respectively, with the POA&M shown above for the West Beach Landfill and the 1943-1956 Disposal Area. Formal concurrence by the RWQCB should be requested no later than 25 July 1988.
