Dear Mr. Ritchie:

This is in response to your letter dated 11 April 1990 regarding scheduling of the Solid Waste Assessment Test (SWAT) at the 1943-1956 Landfill and the West Beach Landfill areas at Naval Air Station (NAS) Alameda. The Navy initially scheduled the SWAT to begin in February 1991 as phases 5 and 6 of the NAS Alameda Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study schedule.

As requested in your letter, the Navy is making every effort to expedite the SWAT to start as soon as possible. The Navy's current plans are for moving the SWAT ahead to start in the fall of 1990. This was discussed in a telephone conversation between R. Cate (NAS Alameda Code 52) and B. Dizon (Western Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command Code 1813BD) on 8 June 1990.
