**DRAFT FINAL FIELD INVESTIGATION WORK PLAN, SITE 7A, INTERIM  
REMOVAL ACTION, NAVAL AIR STATION, ALAMEDA**

The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control and Regional Water Quality Control Board have reviewed the draft final Field Investigation Work Plan for the Site 7A Interim Removal Action. This Work Plan is approved and may become final. This approval, however, is contingent on the inclusion of a summary of the April 12, 1994 conference call between the Navy, its consultants, U.S.E.P.A., and the Regional Board in the final Field Investigation Work Plan. California EPA comments on the draft field investigation work plan were resolved during the course of this conference. Because the Department of Toxic Substances Control and the Navy Base Environmental Coordinator were not present during the call, minutes must be included to insure project consistency.
