**ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR SITE 15 REMOVAL ACTION, NAVAL AIR STATION,
ALAMEDA**

The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) have reviewed the Action Memorandum for the Site 15 Removal Action. This action is an interim action and does not constitute the final remediation for this site. Site 15 is within Operable Unit 2. The Remedial Action Plan for Operable Unit 2 is scheduled for March 1997.

The DTSC and RWQCB comments on the August 12, 1994 draft Action memorandum have been satisfactorily addressed. The DTSC and the RWQCB concurs with the contents of the Action Memorandum and with the Removal Action at Site 15 under State Authority granted in Chapter 6.8 of the California Health and Safety Code.
